The Annual Lifeboat Parade 25th June 1894

The large steamer looking, if anything, brighter than ever, was decked with flowers and manned with four firemen, fully equipped, and Superintendent Pound, who in years gone by fought his way through many a terrific gale and now devoted himself to fighting the flames. The steamer was drawn by three horses, the leader being ridden by a fireman, and as the turn-out proceeded along at a spanking pace many a hearty cheer was given. Every coign of vantage along the route was occupied, and the greatest enthusiasm prevailed.
